## TARDINESS TO CLASSES

## **HEALTH AND FITNESS**

Every student enrolled in Health and Fitness at Northwood Middle School participates in a full program of daily activity. A student must be completely dressed in workout clothes in order to receive full credit for the day. ## **IMMUNIZATION LAW**
